**SUBJECT:** **ALLOCATION OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS FUNDS** (District: 2)

**SUMMARY:**

**Overview**

Several communities in East County have demonstrated a need for improvements to their community or recreational facilities, and have shown that they are prepared to work together with other jurisdictions and community members to provide their communities with opportunities to stay active. This action will provide funds to several organizations to improve community or recreational facilities in East County.

**Recommendation(s)**

**SUPERVISOR JACOB:**

1. Authorize Ramona Parks & Recreation Association to use \$23,400 of previously awarded District Two Community Projects funds (FY 04-05) to upgrade the existing lighting at the Fred Grand Arena with more energy efficient arena lighting fixtures.
2. Allocate \$43,000 from the District Two Community Projects Fund (Org. 0262) to the Boys & Girls Club of East County for the La Mesa Teen Center Capital Campaign to purchase carpeting and flooring, game tables, computers and kitchen equipment.
3. Authorize the Chief Financial Officer to execute an amendment to the grant agreement with Ramona Parks & Recreation Association and a grant agreement with the Boys & Girls Club of East County, establishing terms for the receipt of the funds described above.
4. Find that these grant awards have a public purpose.

**Fiscal Impact**

The fiscal impact of these recommendations is \$43,000. The funding source is FY 05-06 District Two Community Projects. This action will result in the addition of no new staff years and no future costs.

**BACKGROUND:**

**SUBJECT: ALLOCATION OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS FUNDS (District: 2)**

The Ramona Rodeo is an event that is attended by thousands of lovers of the sport from all over the county and beyond. Over the years, the lighting at the stadium has become less efficient. Today's action will authorize Ramona Parks & Recreation Association to use \$23,400 of previously awarded District Two Community Projects funds (FY 04-05) to upgrade the existing lighting at the Fred Grand Arena with more energy efficient arena lighting fixtures.

The Boys & Girls Clubs of East County have offered a safe haven to children between the ages of 6 - 18 in El Cajon, Lakeside and Santee since 1960, providing an escape from drugs and gang activity and offering a "home away from home." The construction of the new Boys & Girls Club La Mesa Teen Center will provide a unique partnership with the County and City of La Mesa, developing inter-generational programs, parent trainings and senior activities, meeting the needs of numerous families in La Mesa. Today's allocation of \$43,000 from the District Two Community Projects Fund (Org. 0262) to the Boys & Girls Club of East County for the La Mesa Teen Center Capital Campaign will purchase carpeting and flooring, game tables, computers and kitchen equipment.
