SUBJECT: NEIGHBORHOOD REINVESTMENT PROGRAM GRANTS (DISTRICT: 2)

Overview

Funding for the Neighborhood Reinvestment Program was included in the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Operational Plan in order to further public purposes throughout San Diego County. Today's action will provide funds for a street fair and for lighting and sound equipment at an east county school.

Recommendation(s)

VICE-CHAIRWOMAN DIANNE JACOB

1. Allocate \$3,500.00 from the District Two Neighborhood Reinvestment Program (org 15655) to the Rolando Community Council for materials for the Rolando Street Fair located at 4800 Rolando Boulevard, San Diego, CA 92115.
2. Allocate \$28,708.30 from the District Two Neighborhood Reinvestment Program (org 15655) to the La Mesa Arts Foundation for lighting and sound equipment at the La Mesa Arts Academy located at 4200 Parks Avenue in La Mesa, CA 91941.
3. Establish appropriations of \$8,768.19 in the Neighborhood Reinvestment Program budget (Org 15655) based on the return of the unused portion of a prior year allocation so the funds can be allocated to other projects. **(4 VOTES)**
4. Authorize the Chief Administrative Officer/Auditor and Controller to execute grant agreements with the organizations above establishing the terms for receipt of the funds and to make minor amendments to the agreements that are consistent with the general purpose of the grant but do not increase the grant.
5. Find that these grant awards have a public purpose.
6. Find that the allocation to the Rolando Community Council is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) by Section 15323 of the CEQA Guidelines and the allocation to the La Mesa Arts Foundation is exempt from CEQA review pursuant to

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CEQA Guidelines Section 15301.

Fiscal Impact

The cost of these projects is \$32,208.30. Funds for this request are included in the Fiscal Year 2015-2016 Operational Plan for the Neighborhood Reinvestment Program (Org 15655). The funding source is General Fund fund balance. This action will result in the addition of no new staff years and no future costs.

Background

Today's allocation of \$3,500 to the Rolando Community Council will provide funds for banners, equipment, t-shirts, materials and supplies for the Rolando Street Fair. The Rolando Street Fair is an annual event organized by the Rolando Community Council that brings the community together, creates a sense of belonging and pride, and encourages local resident participation in community affairs and events. An estimated 15,000 residents attend annually and the fair will showcase local businesses, service organizations and inspire volunteerism and civic engagement. The Rolando Community Council helps to strengthen the community's involvement and funds for these much needed supplies will help the Council achieve their goal of holding a successful street fair.

Today's allocation of \$28,708.30 to the La Mesa Arts Foundation will assist with the installation of permanent lighting and sound equipment at the La Mesa Arts Academy. The La Mesa Arts Academy is a visual and performing arts school that serves 4th-8th graders and promotes arts education and development. This funding will provide much needed permanent equipment in the auditorium and theater room so that students may continue to have the space and equipment available for rehearsals and performances.
