**NEIGHBORHOOD REINVESTMENT PROGRAM GRANTS (DISTRICT: 2)**

**OVERVIEW**

Funding for the Neighborhood Reinvestment Program (NRP) is included in the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Operational Plan in order to further public purposes throughout San Diego County.

**RECOMMENDATION(S)**

**CHAIRWOMAN DIANNE JACOB**

1. Allocate \$39,198 from the District Two Neighborhood Reinvestment Program (org 15655) to the Ramona Unified School District for costs associated with the purchase and installation of a playground structure at James Duke Elementary School in Ramona, CA.
2. Find that the grant award described above has a public purpose.
3. Authorize the Deputy Chief Administrative Officer/Chief Financial Officer to execute a grant agreement with the organization awarded Neighborhood Reinvestment Program funds establishing terms for receipt of the funds and to make minor amendments to the agreement that are consistent with the general purpose of the grant but do not increase the grant.
4. Find that the grant identified in Recommendation No. 1 is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) by Section 15301 of the CEQA Guidelines.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The fiscal impact of these recommendations is \$39,198. Funds for these requests are included in the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Operational Plan for the Neighborhood Reinvestment Program (Org 15655). The funding source is General Purpose Revenue. These actions will result in the addition of no new staff years and no additional costs.

**Ramona Unified School District**

Ramona Unified School District serves approximately 5,500 students in Ramona at 5 elementary schools, a middle school, a high school and several alternative education campuses. If approved, today's grant award of \$39,198 will partially fund the purchase and installation of a new playground structure for James Duke Elementary School. This project is a partnership between the Ramona Unified School District, the PTA, Friends of the Ramona Unified School District (FORUS) and through external grants. This project benefits the community at James Duke Elementary School by providing students with safe and modern play structure that reduces the District's maintenance budget as the current play structure is old and in need of repair with parts no longer available.
